Amended HJ 11<sup>th</sup> LD: HB 1083, HB 1041, HB 1096, HB 1085

### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1039      revise the rule-making authority of the Human Resources Commissioner regarding the drug screening program for certain state employees. (Introduced)
- HB 1040      increase the frequency of background investigations for certain state employees. (Introduced)

### SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1006      authorize the secretary of revenue to contract with certain entities for purposes of creating or maintaining a database to determine agricultural income value and to specify the mandatory and permissive data of the database. (House Taxation Engrossed)
- HB 1063      revise certain provisions regarding the purchase, distribution, and sale of tobacco products to persons under the age of twenty-one. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- HB 1062      increase the financial empowerment of state residents. (Introduced)
