1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require a school district to which a former contracting
2 school district is annexed to assign certain resident students to a school district in a
3 bordering state.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That § 13-28-19.1 be amended to read as follows:

6 13-28-19.1. If a school district that was contracting pursuant to § 13-15-11, ~~reorganizes with~~
7 dissolves and is annexed to an adjoining school district prior to July 1, 2009, ~~at the request of~~
8 ~~the parents of the students of the former school district~~, the school board for the ~~reorganized~~
9 school district to which the former contracting school district is annexed shall, for the current
10 school year and for each school year thereafter, assign the students ~~from who reside in land area~~
11 that was part of the former contracting district to the school that was receiving the students
12 under the contract. ~~All such requests shall be included as a part of the school district~~
13 ~~reorganization plan required by § 13-6-10. If the parent or guardian of a student assigned to a~~
14 school district in a bordering state pursuant to this section disapproves of the student's
15 assignment, the school board shall assign that student to an attendance center within the district.



- 1 However, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the school district is not required to
- 2 provide transportation to that student.
