1	An Act to require that school district elections occur in conjunction with the general
2	election.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
4	Section 1. That § 13-6-62 be AMENDED:
5	13-6-62. New school districtElection of boardNotices and declarations of
6	candidacyCosts.
7	If under <del>the provisions of t</del> his chapter a new school district <del>entity i</del> s created, the
8	voters shall elect a <del>new school</del> board to govern <del>such school the new</del> district <del>as hereinafter</del>
9	<del>provided</del> .
10	The <del>county auditor</del> of the county having jurisdiction shall conduct the election
11	under the existing_statutory provisions for conducting annual_board_elections in school
12	districts. The <del>county a</del> uditor shall perform the duties specified for the business manager
13	<del>as provided</del> in chapter 13-7 <del>, as amended</del> and shall <del>also give the</del> <u>provide</u> notice <del>of</del>
14	<u>regarding</u> the number of <del>school</del> board vacancies and <u>the</u> residency requirements for <del>school</del>
15	board membership, as may be set forth in the plan approved by the voters.

However, provided that</u> if <u>a new-the new</u> district does not 7 become operational, the contracts are void.

8 The board shall meet as often as it deems necessary before the new district 9 becomes operational, and its. Any expenses shall constitute a legal claim incurred by the 10 <u>board</u> under §§ 13-8-37 and 13-8-38, <u>constitute a legal claim</u> to be paid by the <del>new</del> district 11 when <u>it becomes</u> operational.
