1 An Act to provide for the renewal of an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 23-7-8.13 be AMENDED:

23-7-8.13. Grace period for renewal of permit.
Upon the expiration of a permit to carry a concealed pistol that was issued pursuant
to this chapter, the permit holder has a sixty-day thirty-day grace period to renew the
permit. During the grace period, the permit holder may continue to carry a concealed
pistol.

9 Section 2. That § 23-7-56 be AMENDED:

23-7-56. Enhanced permit to carry concealed pistol--Renewal.

11 The holder of the <u>A person who holds an enhanced permit to carry a concealed</u> 12 pistol may renew the permit through the sheriff of the county-where the holder in which 13 the person resides for <u>a</u>. The period beginning ninety for renewal begins one-hundred 14 eighty days before the permit expires and ending ends thirty days after expiration of the 15 permit, if the holder pays the expires.
