- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** That § 26-8D-9 be AMENDED:

## 26-8D-9. Council meetings--Tasks.

The oversight council shall meet within ninety days following appointment and shall meet semiannually thereafter. The oversight council terminates <u>five\_eight\_years</u> after its first meeting, unless the Legislature, <u>by\_joint\_resolution</u>, continues the oversight council for a specified period of time. The oversight council may:

- (1) Review the recommendations of the juvenile justice reinvestment initiative work group in the final report dated November 2014, track implementation, and evaluate compliance with this chapter;
- (2) Review performance measures and outcome measures required by this chapter and proposed by the Department of Corrections, Unified Judicial System, and Department of Social Services;
- (3) Review performance measures and outcome measures submitted semiannually by the Department of Corrections, Unified Judicial System, and Department of Social Services pursuant to §§ 26-8D-4, 26-8D-12, 26-8D-15, 26-8D-16, 26-8D-19, and 26-8D-20;
- (4) Review efforts by the Department of Social Services to ensure delivery of treatment in rural areas and related performance measures;
- Track progress and make recommendations to improve outcomes for Native
  American children in the juvenile justice system in accordance with §§ 26-8D-5 and
  24 26-8D-6;
- 25 (6) Review the payments of the diversion incentive program to counties, pursuant to \$ 26-8D-2, payments from the juvenile justice detention cost-sharing fund pursuant

1		to § 26-8D-24, and performance-based reimbursement payments to group care and
2		residential treatment centers pursuant to §§ 26-8D-17 and 26-8D-18; and
3	(7)	Prepare and submit an annual summary report of the performance and outcome
4		measures that are part of this chapter to the Legislature, Governor, and Chief
5		Justice. The report shall include any recommendations for improvement related to
