# Senate Bill 146

Introduced by: **Senator** Heinert

1 **An Act to revise provisions related to tribal identification cards.**

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 **Section 1.** That § 1-54-7 be AMENDED:

4 **1-54-7. Tribal identification cards.**

5 A tribal identification card is a valid form of identification for all purposes relating  
6 to commerce, including for all purposes relating to banks or financial institutions for which  
7 a South Dakota nondriver identification card or a South Dakota driver license may be  
8 used. Furthermore, tribal identification cards shall be accepted as valid forms of  
9 identification for the purpose of cashing checks wherever checks may be cashed and for  
10 purposes where the age of the person needs to be verified. For purposes of this section  
11 and §§ 22-40-9, 22-40-18, and 34-46-1, the term, tribal identification card, means an  
12 unexpired identification card issued by a South Dakota tribal government of a tribe  
13 recognized by the Bureau of Indian Affairs, United States Department of the Interior, that  
14 contains the legal name, date of birth, signature, and picture of the enrolled tribal  
15 member.
