HB 1054 (Deferred from 11<sup>th</sup> LD) revise the documentation required for voter registration. (House Local Government Engrossed)

HB 1032 (Deferred from 11<sup>th</sup> LD) revise the authority of the Board of Education Standards to promulgate rules regarding certification. (Introduced)

HB 1033 (Deferred from 11<sup>th</sup> LD) provide for the prevention of aquatic invasive species contamination in public waters and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

HB 1083 rename the postsecondary technical institutes as technical colleges.  
(House Education Engrossed)

HB 1041 revise provisions authorizing state employees to opt-out of the state employee health plan and to declare an emergency.  
(House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

HB 1096 prohibit commercial surrogacy contracts and provide a penalty for facilitating a commercial surrogacy. (House Judiciary Engrossed)

HB 1085 provide for permanent daylight savings time. (House State Affairs Engrossed)

HB 1060 revise certain provisions regarding the use of the aeronautics fund.
