A LEGISLATIVE COMMEMORATION, To commend and acknowledge the Ground Works and South Dakota Agriculture in the Classroom as a South Dakota educational nonprofit that incorporates interactive computer activities, youth summer camps, and teaching gardens to deliver hands-on lessons in STEAM education, agriculture literacy, health and wellness, and student leadership.

6 WHEREAS, Ground Works has been an established 501(c) 3 nonprofit in the state of South

- 8 WHEREAS, Ground Works created SD Road Trip, a curriculum of Ground Works and SD
- 9 Agriculture in the Classroom. This is an online digital curriculum with 8,038 students enrolled

10 in 100 of the 150 South Dakota school districts; and

11 WHEREAS, South Dakota educational standards for the fourth-grade mandate history

12 education be taught a minimum of 100 hours a school year, the SD Road Trip covers those

13 content standards in social studies, and standards in math, language arts, science, and

14 <u>agriculture literacy; and</u>

15 WHEREAS, Ground Works and South Dakota Ag in the Classroom is dedicated to providing

- 16 <u>quality education to the next generation leaders, consumers, and policy makers; and</u>
- 17 WHEREAS, agriculture is South Dakota's number one industry; and

18 <u>WHEREAS</u>, both education and agriculture remain a top priority to South Dakota residents
