- 1 An Act to revise certain sheriff's fees and costs.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **Section 1.** That § 10-22-28 be AMENDED:

10-22-28. Sheriff's Fees--Costs--Collection of taxes.

The sheriff is allowed the following fees for collecting taxes—the following—fees: twenty-five dollars for making the sheriff's return on the sheriff's warrant of authority; fifteen—fifty—dollars for each levy; and ten dollars—for each sale—and necessary costs of the for each sale. The fees and costs shall be collected from the tax debtor or the tax debtor's property. If actual travel is made in collecting taxes, the—The—sheriff shall also collect from the tax debtor or the tax debtor's property an additional penalty, in—lieu—of mileage, equal to—fifteen fifty dollars or six—percent of the amount of tax and interest due, whichever is more. The fees and costs collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited in the county general fund. The sheriff shall receive from the county mileage—for each mile actually and necessarily traveled at the rate provided by law.—However, the sheriff is not allowed mileage—for collecting taxes within the corporate limits—of the county seat.

Section 2. That § 10-56-22 be AMENDED:

10-56-22. Sheriff's Fees--Costs--Collection of taxes.

The sheriff shall collect the following fees for collecting taxes: twenty-five dollars for making the sheriff's return on the sheriff's warrant of authority; fifteen fifty dollars for each levy; ten dollars for each sale; and the necessary costs of distress and sale. The fees and costs shall be collected from the tax debtor or the tax debtor's property. If actual travel is made in collecting taxes, the The sheriff shall also collect from the tax debtor or the tax debtor's property an additional penalty, in lieu of mileage, equal to fifteen fifty dollars or six percent of the amount of tax and interest due, which, with all, whichever is more. All fees and costs collected, shall be credited to the general fund of the county.
