1A JOINT RESOLUTION, Rescinding House Joint Resolutions calling for a2constitutional convention for the sole purpose of changing the Constitution of3the United States.

4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF
5 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of South Dakota, in 2015, adopted House Joint

7 <u>Resolution 1001 making formal application to Congress to call for a constitutional convention</u>

8 for the sole purpose of altering the Constitution of the United States of America:

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Ninety-Fifth Legislature of the

10 State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that House Joint

11 Resolution 1001, adopted in 2015, be rescinded; and

12 <u>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</u>, that the secretary of state transmit copies of this resolution to

13 the President of the United States, the Speaker and Clerk of the United States House of

14 Representatives, the President and Secretary of the United States Senate, the members of

15 the South Dakota congressional delegation, and the Governor of the State of South Dakota,

16 <u>attesting the adoption of this resolution by the Legislature of the State of South Dakota.</u>
