13-1-66. Traditional tribal regalia--Objects of cultural significance--Honor songs--Permissions.

The state, any of its political subdivisions, municipalities, or <u>any</u> subdivisions thereof shall of municipalities may not prohibit any person from wearing traditional tribal regalia or objects of cultural significance <u>or from the singing of an honor song</u> at a school honoring or graduation ceremony. For purposes of this section the term, tribal regalia or object of cultural significance, means an eagle feather—or, an eagle plume, or a beaded graduation cap.
