CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

Amended SJ 16th LD: SB 18, SB 60

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 137 revise provisions for repair, replacement, and construction of sidewalks within a municipality. (Introduced)
- HB 1006 authorize the secretary of revenue to contract with certain entities for purposes of creating or maintaining a database to determine agricultural income value and to specify the mandatory and permissive data of the database. (House Engrossed)
- HB 1022 revise certain provisions regarding dealer licenses for motor vehicle, snowmobile, and boat sales. (House Transportation Engrossed)
- HB 1038 revise certain provisions regarding manufactured home construction and safety standards. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 92 (Deferred from 15th LD) to provide for the repurposing of STAR Academy. (Introduced)
- SB 26 (Deferred from 15th LD) increase the assessment of liquidated court costs and to revise the disposition of the funds collected. (Introduced)
- SB 90 (Deferred from 16th LD) revise the distribution of motor fuel tax revenue, create a small structure and large culvert fund, provide for the use and administration of the fund, and to make an appropriation thereof. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- SB 80 revise certain sheriff's fees and costs. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 98 extend the notification period for possession of a concealed pistol in the state capitol. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 135 increase the bid limit for certain public improvements. (Introduced)
- SJR 501 Proposing and submitting to the voters an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, providing for wagering on sporting events and to revise provisions regarding certain municipal proceeds of gaming revenues. (Introduced)

- SB 70 authorize other languages to be used in the process of issuing certain driver licenses and permits. (Senate Transportation Engrossed)
- SB 19 revise certain provisions regarding marriage and family therapists. (Introduced)
- SB 16 make an appropriation to reimburse certain health care professionals who have complied with the requirements for certain health care recruitment assistance programs and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 37 make an appropriation for costs related to disasters in the state and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
