On page 1, line 1, of the Introduced bill, after "to " insert "require non-opioid alternatives to pain management"

On the Introduced bill, delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added:

...

34-20A-114. Pain management-Non-opioid alternatives-Exceptions.

Before a health care provider, acting within the scope of the provider's practice, may prescribe an opioid for the purpose of mitigating or alleviating a patient's pain, the provider shall recommend a non-opioid alternative for pain management. For purposes of this section, such alternatives include acupuncture, chiropractic services, massage therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, and participation in a pain management program. The restriction set forth in this section does not apply:

- (1) To a provider who, using sound medical judgment, determines and documents in the patient's medical file that:
 - (a) Following a major physical trauma or a surgical procedure, the patient's risk of adverse effects from pain outweighs the risk of opioid usage; or
 - (b) The patient would receive the greatest benefit from a course of treatment that includes an opioid prescription, while simultaneously pursuing a pain management alternative; or
- (2) In the case of a patient who is receiving:
 - (a) Treatment for cancer;
 - (b) Palliative care;
 - (c) Hospice care; or
 - (d) Treatment for an opioid use disorder.
