AMENDMENT 1244A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

An Act to authorize forensic medical examinations for certain persons. 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 2 3 Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added: 22-22-26.3. Forensic medical examination--Informed Consent--Liability or 4 5 discipline. 6 A physician, hospital, or clinic may provide a forensic medical examination, as 7 defined under § 22-22-26, without the consent of a guardian or conservator of a protected 8 person, as defined under § 29A-5-102, to any protected person who provides informed 9 consent. If a patient has a quardian or conservator, the physician, hospital, or clinic shall 10 take reasonable steps make a good faith effort to notify the guardian or conservator that an examination has taken placebefore the forensic medical examination that the patient 11 12 provided informed consent for the examination and the examination will take place, unless 13 the guardian or conservator is the suspected perpetrator. 14 A physician, hospital, or clinic who in good faith believes that a patient is incapable 15 of giving informed consent under this section may not be subject to criminal prosecution, 16 civil liability, or professional discipline for failing to follow the patient's direction or for 17 making the determination. 18 A physician, hospital, or clinic who in good faith believes that a patient is capable 19 of giving informed consent under this section may not be subject to criminal prosecution, 20 civil liability, or professional discipline for following a patient's direction or for making the 21 determination. 22 For purposes of this section, the term, informed consent, means consent 23 voluntarily, knowingly, and competently given without any element of force, fraud, deceit, 24 duress, threat, or other form of coercion after conscientious explanation of all information 25 that a reasonable person would consider significant to the decision in a manner reasonably 26 comprehensible to general lay understanding.
