SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 97 title vehicles older than thirty years with no existing record. (Introduced)
- HB 1055 revise certain provisions regarding the termination of a political committee under certain circumstances. (House Engrossed)
- HB 1040 increase the frequency of background investigations for certain state employees. (Introduced)
- HB 1061 exempt vehicles owned by improvement districts from certain vehicle registration fees. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 92 (Deferred from 17th LD) to provide for the repurposing of STAR Academy. (Introduced)
- SB 26 (Deferred from 17th LD) increase the assessment of liquidated court costs and to revise the disposition of the funds collected. (Introduced)

- SB 90 (Deferred from 17th LD) revise the distribution of motor fuel tax revenue, create a small structure and large culvert fund, provide for the use and administration of the fund, and to make an appropriation thereof. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- SJR 501 (Deferred from 17th LD) Proposing and submitting to the voters an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, providing for wagering on sporting events and to revise provisions regarding certain municipal proceeds of gaming revenues. (Introduced)
- SB 137 (Removed from consent calendar 17th LD) revise provisions for repair, replacement, and construction of sidewalks within a municipality. (Introduced)
- SB 18 revise certain provisions regarding professional counselors. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 60 adopt the Physical Therapist Licensure Compact. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 103 limit the disclosure of presidential election results and to provide for a suspension of such disclosure. (Introduced)
- SB 111 exclude certain wind energy tax revenue from the state aid to education formula. (Introduced)
