- HB 1113 provide for remote participation in a shareholders' meeting. (Introduced)
- HB 1114 authorize additional abbreviations in naming corporations, limited liability companies, and limited liability partnerships. (Introduced)
- HB 1153 authorize the limited possession of a knife in the state capitol. (Introduced)
- HB 1178 revise the seller's property condition disclosure statement. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1127 (Deferred from 17th LD) revise provisions regarding real estate appraisers. (Introduced)
- HB 1065 (Deferred from 17th LD) revise drone surveillance protections. (House Judiciary Engrossed)
- HB 1089 (Removed from Consent Calendar) provide for the discharge of certain persons who received a suspended imposition of sentence for a misdemeanor. (Introduced)
- HB 1008 (Deferred from 17th LD) legalize the growth, production, and transportation of industrial hemp in the state, and to declare an emergency.
 - (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- HB 1099 (Deferred from 17th LD) authorize counties to impose a temporary voterapproved half-cent sales and use tax and to issue revenue bonds to fund certain county infrastructure construction. (House Taxation Engrossed)
- HB 1164 (Deferred from 17th LD) codify legislation enacted in 2019. (Introduced)
- HB 1126 provide authority for real estate brokers to conduct real property evaluations. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

- HJR 5001 To apply for a convention of states under Article V of the Constitution of the United States to impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, to limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and to limit the terms of office for federal officials and members of Congress. (Introduced) (Fiscal Note)
- HB 1131 prohibit the use of misleading identification for telephonic communications. (Introduced)
- HB 1152 provide financial assistance for school sentinel training. (Introduced)
- HB 1173 prohibit a school board from denying an application for open enrollment from certain students with autism. (Introduced)
