

**REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEE – Senate Commerce and Energy**

The Committee on Senate Commerce and Energy respectfully reports that it has had under consideration **SB 108** which was tabled.

The Committee on Senate Commerce and Energy respectfully reports that it has had under consideration **SB 119** and returns the same with the recommendation that said bill do pass.

The Committee on Senate Commerce and Energy respectfully reports that it has had under consideration **SB 139** and returns the same with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

139A

On page 1, line 17, of the Introduced bill, after "deficiencies;" insert " or"

On page 1, line 18, of the Introduced bill, after "deficiencies;

(6)" delete "Improve operations or increase services; or"

On page 1, line 19, of the Introduced bill, after "or" delete "(7)"

And that as so amended, said bill do pass.

Also MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committee on Senate Commerce and Energy respectfully reports that it has had under consideration **SB 146** and returns the same with the recommendation that said bill be amended as follows:

146B

On page 1, line 15, of the Introduced bill, after "member." insert " Reasonable reliance upon a tribal identification card as proof of age of the purchaser or the recipient of an age restricted product is a complete defense to any action brought against a person for the sale or distribution of a product that is subject to state or federal age-related purchase and possession restrictions."

And that as so amended, said bill do pass.

Also MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committee on Senate Commerce and Energy respectfully reports that it has had under consideration the nomination of Joseph F. Kafka of Minnehaha County, Valley Springs, South Dakota, to the South Dakota Lottery Commission and returns the same with the recommendation that the Senate advise and consent to the confirmation of said reappointment, and that said reappointment be placed on the consent calendar.
