## 1 An Act to to revise provisions regarding group pheasant hunts for disabled veterans.

- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **Section 1.** That § 41-11-5.5 be AMENDED:

## 41-11-5.5. Pheasant hunt--Disabled veterans and former prisoners of war--Promulgation of rules.

6 Any nonprofit organization may establish a special pheasant hunt in which disabled 7 veterans or Purple Heart recipients of the United States Armed Forces may participate. 8 The special pheasant hunt may be held before or during the regular pheasant season. No 9 fee may be charged to participants in any such special pheasant hunt, by either the state 10 or the sponsoring organization. The Game, Fish and Parks Commission shall promulgate 11 rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, to administer the special pheasant hunts authorized in 12 this section.

For the purposes of this section a disabled veteran of the United States Armed Forces
 is a resident or nonresident is a person who meets one of the following criteria established
 in subdivisions 41-6-10.2(1) or (2):

- 16(1)A resident or nonresident veteran who has been adjudicated by the United States17Department of Veterans Affairs as twenty percent or more disabled due to a18service-connected disability or has received the United States Department of19Veterans Affairs K Award; or
- 20 (2) A resident who has served on active duty in the armed forces of the United States
  21 or has served as a member of the armed forces reserve or national guard, and the
  22 resident is forty percent or more disabled for the purposes of receiving social
  23 security benefits.
