## House Concurrent Resolution 6007

SENATE EDUCATION ENGROSSED

## 1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Supporting students and other persons afflicted by 2 epilepsy and raising awareness of epilepsy in South Dakota.

- 3 <u>WHEREAS, epilepsy is a disease characterized by an enduring predisposition to generate</u>
- 4 epileptic seizures and by the neurobiological, cognitive, psychological, and social
- 5 <u>consequences of this condition; and</u>
- 6 WHEREAS, a seizure is an event, and epilepsy is the disease involving recurrent
- 7 <u>unprovoked seizures that is the fourth most common neurological disorder and affects people</u>
- 8 of all ages; and
- 9 WHEREAS, epilepsy is a spectrum condition with a wide range of seizure types and control
- 10 varying from person-to-person; and
- 11 WHEREAS, one in twenty-six people will be diagnosed with epilepsy at some point in life
- 12 and one in ten people will suffer a seizure at some point in life; and
- 13 WHEREAS, historical treatment of persons living with epilepsy has led to false, unsafe
- 14 <u>understandings of the disease and a significant underfunding of research when compared to</u>
- 15 <u>other diseases; and</u>
- 16 WHEREAS, 3.4 million people in the United States battle epilepsy every day, including
- 17 over nine thousand people in South Dakota, and over one thousand children who are among
- 18 the most vulnerable members of our state; and
- 19 WHEREAS, creating awareness of epilepsy will promote much-needed fundraising, seizure
- 20 safety, and first aid knowledge to ensure the safety of our students and other citizens living
- 21 with epilepsy; and

1	WHEREAS, the safety of students with epilepsy in South Dakota's schools is increased only
2	through awareness of the disease by school boards and administration, teachers, support
3	staff, parents, and the public at large; and
4	WHEREAS, the Epilepsy Foundation has free online or in-person resources available to
5	schools and the public at large, including training programs that provide an overview of
6	seizures and epilepsy, seizure first aid, seizure action plans, rescue therapies, seizure
7	emergencies, and how to support students in school settings:
