HB 1032 (Deferred from  $20^{th}$  LD) revise the authority of the Board of Education

Standards to promulgate rules regarding certification. (Introduced)

HB 1023	(Deferred from 20 <sup>th</sup> LD) permit the secretary of revenue to issue cease and desist orders and to impose a civil penalty on certain public auctions. (Introduced)
HB 1084	increase the maximum allowable height of certain vehicles carrying baled feed and to declare an emergency. (House Transportation Engrossed)
