## House Bill 1265

AMENDMENT 1265A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1	An Act to revise provisions regarding off-sale delivery licenses for the delivery of		
2	alcoholic beverages <u>together with food products</u> .		
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5	Section 1. That § 35-4-127 be AMENDED:		
6	<del>35-4-127. Off-sale delivery-license.</del>		
7	A licensee licensed pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(3) or (5) may apply for an off-sale delivery		
8	license as provided by subdivision 35-4-2(23) to deliver alcoholic beverages to a consumer		
9	within the boundaries of the municipality that issued the off-sale license. The alcoholic		
10	beverage for delivery shall be purchased in person and on-site at the licensee's off-sale		
11	premises. The minimum purchase of alcoholic beverages shall be one hundred fifty dollars.		
12	The delivery shall be made during hours of operation pursuant to § 35-4-81.2 by an employee		
13	of the licensee who is at least twenty-one years old. The employee shall obtain the signature		
14	of a person twenty-one years old or older before delivery of the shipment. The employee shall		
15	request that the person signing for the delivery display a valid age-bearing photo identification		
16	document issued by this state, another state, or the federal government verifying that the		
17	person is twenty-one years old or older. Documentation verifying the identification of the		
18	person signing for the delivery shall be retained by the licensee for one year.		
19	Any licensee who delivers alcoholic beverages to a person under twenty-one years old is		
20	subject to a civil penalty of one thousand dollars for a first offense and two thousand dollars		
21	for a second or subsequent offense. Any money collected pursuant to this section shall be		
22	deposited in the general fund.

2	A licensee licensed pursuant to subdivision 35-4-2(3) or (5) may apply for an off-				
3	sale delivery license with food as provided by subdivision 35-4-2(24) to deliver alcoholic				
4	beverages together with food and good ingredients as defined in § 10-45-1 to a consumer				
5	within the boundaries of the municipality that issued the off-sale license. The order for the				
6	delivery of alcoholic beverages shall be placed with the off-sale delivery licensee before				
7	noon on the day of delivery.				
8	The delivery shall be made during hours of operation pursuant to § 35-4-81.2 by				
9	an employee of the licensee who is at least twenty-one years old. The employee shall				
10	obtain the signature of a person twenty-one years old or older before delivery of the				
11	shipment. The employee shall request that the person signing for the delivery display a				
12	<u>valid</u>	age-bearing photo identification document issued by this state, another state, or the			
13	federal government verifying that the person is twenty-one years old or older.				
14	Documentation verifying the identification of the person signing for the delivery shall be				
15	retained by the licensee for one year.				
16	Any licensee who delivers alcoholic beverages to a person under twenty-one years				
17	old is subject to a civil penalty of one thousand dollars for a first offense and two thousand				
18	<u>dollar</u>	rs for a second or subsequent offense. Any money collected pursuant to this section			
19	<u>shall</u>	be deposited in the general fund.

3		amount that could be charged as if the municipality had not been authorized to
4		obtain on-sale licenses pursuant to § 35-3-13. The renewal fee shall be the same
5		as could be charged for a like license in the nearest municipality;
