SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1048 revise certain requirements for certain advisory committees under the Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners, Board of Nursing, and Board of Social Work Examiners. (Introduced)
- HB 1086 repeal certain fees charged by a clerk of courts. (Introduced)
- HB 1120 authorize the governing body of a second or third class municipality to act as a planning and zoning commission. (Introduced)
- HB 1105 revise certain provisions regarding restrictions on State Investment Council members. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1106 authorize the state investment officer to include an indemnity provision in certain investment-related documents. (Introduced)
- HB 1059 revise certain provisions regarding hunting with drones. (Introduced)
- HB 1082 revise the conditions under which a licensed vehicle dealer may display or sell certain vehicles. (House Transportation Engrossed)
- HB 1091 revise provisions regarding the compensation of merchandise dealers for diagnostic and warranty work. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 162 (Removed from Consent) provide limitations on the use of lighting equipment while hunting. (Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- SB 167 (Removed from Consent) revise a provision regarding eligibility for the South Dakota opportunity scholarship. (Introduced)

SB 155 (Deferred from 22nd LD) provide for step therapy protocol regarding certain prescription drugs. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1007 require certain adjustments to the assessed value of agricultural land if factors impact the land's productivity and to require those adjustments to be documented. (House Taxation Engrossed)

HB 1060 revise certain provisions regarding the use of the aeronautics fund. (Introduced)
