Senate Page Resolution 3

- SB 28 (Consideration of House Amendments) repeal provisions regarding the restricted real estate broker's license for auctioneers and to revise certain provisions regarding real estate licensing. (House Engrossed)
- HCR 6009 Strengthening the sister-state ties between the State of South Dakota and Taiwan; supporting the signing of a Bilateral Trade Agreement (BTA) between Taiwan and the United States; and reaffirming support for increasing Taiwan's international participation. (Introduced)

- HB 1080 revise certain provisions regarding grain buyers. (Introduced)

- SB 167 (Deferred from 23rd LD) revise a provision regarding eligibility for the South Dakota opportunity scholarship. (Introduced)
- SB 150 (Deferred from 22nd LD) (JR 5-17 with pending amendment) revise nonresident waterfowl licensure. (Introduced)
- SB 136 authorize certain witnesses to be accompanied by a certified therapeutic dog in a criminal proceeding. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- SB 157 revise certain provisions regarding the county zoning and appeals process. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1041 revise provisions authorizing state employees to opt-out of the state employee health plan and to declare an emergency. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1063 revise certain provisions regarding the purchase, distribution, and sale of tobacco products to persons under the age of twenty-one. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
