#### MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1156 (Intent to Reconsider Vote by which Lost) to prohibit the conduct of certain physical examinations or screenings on students in a school district without parental consent. (Introduced)
- HB 1081 (Consideration of Senate Amendments) exempt from alcoholic beverage regulations certain uses of alcohol by postsecondary institutions. (Senate Engrossed)
- HCR 6007 (Consideration of Senate Amendments) Supporting students and other persons afflicted by epilepsy and raising awareness of epilepsy in South Dakota. (Senate Education Engrossed)
- HCR 6011 Supporting the Recovering America's Wildlife Act. (Introduced)
- HCR 6016 Supporting the efforts of William "Bill" Casper as the South Dakota state chairman of the State Funeral for World War II Veterans in his efforts to petition President Donald J. Trump to hold a state funeral for World War II veterans. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1184 (Deferred from 23<sup>rd</sup> LD) provide limited deer and antelope licenses to landowners. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- HB 1136 provide for the licensure and regulation of practitioners of acupuncture and Oriental medicine and to establish the Acupuncture Licensing Board and acupuncture regulation fund. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- HB 1070 modify requirements regarding the installation and inspection of certain electrical wiring. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1124 provide for an increase in the assessment against certain treated land. (Introduced)
- HB 1242 provide for the reissuance of certain enhanced permits to carry a concealed pistol and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1166 revise provisions regarding the appointment of inactive watershed district boards and the reactivation of watershed districts. (Introduced)
- HB 1035 make an appropriation from the water and environment fund and its revolving fund subfunds for various water and environmental purposes, to revise the water resources projects list, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 52 create a state seal specialty plate emblem. (Introduced)
