HCR 6016 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) Supporting the efforts of William "Bill" Casper as the South Dakota state chairman of the State Funeral for World War II Veterans in his efforts to petition President Donald J. Trump to hold a state funeral for World War II veterans. (Introduced)

### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

HB 1182 provide for the renewal of an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol. (House State Affairs Engrossed)  
HB 1108 adopt the Uniform Civil Remedies for Unauthorized Disclosure of Intimate Images Act. (Introduced)  
HB 1179 authorize series limited liability companies. (Introduced)

### SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

HB 1104 (Deferred from 23<sup>rd</sup> LD) limit the scope of medical information that may be required as a condition of participation in sanctioned activities. (Introduced)  
HB 1184 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) provide limited deer and antelope licenses to landowners. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)  
HB 1136 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) provide for the licensure and regulation of practitioners of acupuncture and Oriental medicine and to establish the Acupuncture Licensing Board and acupuncture regulation fund. (House Health and Human Services Engrossed)  
HB 1070 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) modify requirements regarding the installation and inspection of certain electrical wiring. (House Commerce and Energy Engrossed)

- HB 1124 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) provide for an increase in the assessment against certain treated land. (Introduced)
- HB 1242 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) provide for the reissuance of certain enhanced permits to carry a concealed pistol and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1166 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) revise provisions regarding the appointment of inactive watershed district boards and the reactivation of watershed districts. (Introduced)
- HB 1035 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) make an appropriation from the water and environment fund and its revolving fund subfunds for various water and environmental purposes, to revise the water resources projects list, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1167 revise provisions regarding confidential communications between a student and certain school employees. (House Education Engrossed)
- HB 1004 provide for the defense of laws by the Legislature. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1195 provide an affirmative defense to pregnant women for certain controlled substance offenses. (House State Affairs Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- HB 1226 revise certain provisions regarding local referendums. (House State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1100 make an appropriation to begin the research and development of a new bioprocessing facility and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1175 define dyslexia for the purposes of special education and related services. (Introduced)
- HB 1068 include out-of-state convictions for the basis of an enhanced penalty for the crime of stalking. (Introduced) (PJPCE)

- SB 52 (Deferred from 24<sup>th</sup> LD) create a state seal specialty plate emblem. (Introduced)
