An Act to require the Board of Regents to assemble a task force to study the possibility of shared administration among the institutions of higher education under the board's authority.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **Section 1.** The Board of Regents shall assemble a task force consisting of at least eleven
- 6 members to examine the possible program and administrative efficiencies and cost
- 7 <u>effectiveness that may be achieved through the shared administration of the South Dakota</u>
- 8 School of Mines and Technology, Black Hills State University, Dakota State University,
- 9 Northern State University, South Dakota State University, and the University of South Dakota.
- 10 All expenses incurred in carrying out the work of the task force shall be paid out of funds
- 11 appropriated or otherwise provided to the board.
- The board shall present the findings of the task force to the Governor and to the

 Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council no later than November 15, 2021.
- 14 **Section 2.** The task force examination shall include the following:
- 15 <u>(1) The possible combining of administration at all levels of operation within an</u> 16 <u>institution;</u>
- 17 (2) The possible combining of operations and functions across multiple institutions;
- 18 (3) The possible combining of the administration of programs across multiple
 19 institutions:
- 20 (4) A review of the duplication of program offerings;
- 21 <u>(5) A review of the academic majors with low enrollments and low numbers of</u> 22 graduates;
- 23 (6) A review of functions outside the core missions of teaching, learning, and research;
- 24 (7) A review of the operations and functions provided as an efficiency through the 25 central office of the Board of Regents;

- 1 (8) A review of the viability of the university centers; and
- 2 (9) Any other possible cost-effective measures the task force determines are worthy
- 3 <u>of examination.</u>
