House Bill 1232**AMENDMENT 1232C FOR THE HOUSE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES BILL**

1 **An Act to provide an appropriation for adoption assistance grants.**

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

4 **25-6-26. South Dakota adoption assistance fund--Creation--Purpose.**

5 There is created in the state treasury the South Dakota adoption assistance fund.
6 The fund consists of any appropriation by the Legislature for deposit in the fund, together
7 with gifts, grants, and donations, from private sources, and all income from and interest
8 earned on the fund.

9 The Department of Social Services shall use the fund to provide grants to families
10 that have incurred expenses associated with obtaining a home study report, in accordance
11 with § 25-6-9.1, or that have incurred expenses for an adoption application, for foster
12 care adoption service fees, or for adoption education costs, in order to adopt a child from
13 the state's foster care system.

14 A grant under this section, if used to assist with the expenses of a home study
15 report, may not exceed the actual charge for the home study report, or three thousand
16 dollars, whichever is less.

17 A grant under this section, if used to assist with any other eligible expenditure,
18 may not exceed the actual charge or two thousand dollars, whichever is less.

19 The grant is payable to any family upon finalization of the adoption and
20 presentation of an invoice or receipt to the department.

21 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of ~~five hundred~~
22 ~~thousand dollars (\$500,000) one dollar (\$1), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the~~
23 Department of Social Services, for purposes of providing adoption assistance grants in
24 accordance with § 26-6-26.

- 1 **Section 3.** The secretary of the Department of Social Services shall approve vouchers and
- 2 the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
