House Bill 1249**AMENDMENT 1249C FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL**

1 **An Act to revise certain provisions regarding the operation of the South Dakota**
2 **Lottery.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

5 **42-7A-66. Video lottery repeal and recovery fund--Establishment--Purposes.**

6 There is established in the state treasury the video lottery repeal and recovery
7 fund. ~~The fund consists of all moneys deposited into the fund in accordance with § 42-7A-~~
8 ~~63, together with any interest or other earnings of the fund.~~ The purpose of the fund is to
9 replace lost revenue for the general fund following the repeal of video lottery. Moneys in
10 the fund may not be expended unless video lottery is repealed. ~~Up to one million dollars~~
11 ~~from the video lottery repeal and recovery fund may be transferred to the general fund,~~
12 ~~if projected lottery revenues for the fiscal year fail to meet the adopted target, as~~
13 ~~determined by the Joint Committee on Appropriations.~~

14 **Section 2.** That § 42-7A-2 be AMENDED:

15 **42-7A-2. South Dakota Lottery established--Administration by executive**
16 **director--Overall control and operation of games.**

17 There is hereby established in the Department of Revenue a division to be called
18 the South Dakota Lottery under the direction of the South Dakota Lottery Commission.
19 Under the supervision of the commission, an executive director shall administer the state
20 lottery as provided in this chapter. In all decisions, the executive director and commission
21 shall take into account the particularly sensitive nature of the lottery, and shall act to
22 promote and ensure the integrity, security, honesty, and fairness of its operation and
23 administration. The overall management of the state lottery and control over the operation
24 of its games shall rest solely with the South Dakota Lottery. The South Dakota Lottery

1 may not promote or advertise, or cause the promotion or advertisement of, any games
2 through any means.

3 **Section 3.** That § 42-7A-22 be AMENDED:

4 **42-7A-22. Lottery operating fund--Continuous appropriation--Informational**
5 **budget--Disbursements.**

6 There is established within the state treasury the lottery operating fund, into which
7 shall be deposited all revenues from the sale of lottery tickets, interest received on moneys
8 in the lottery operating fund, and all other fees and moneys collected. For the purposes
9 of this section, the award of a free ticket or free play does not constitute revenue. All
10 money in the funds created by this section are continuously appropriated for the purposes
11 specified in this section. All funds received by the state lottery shall be set forth in an
12 informational budget as described in § 4-7-7.2 and be annually reviewed by the
13 Legislature. Each year one million dollars shall be transferred to the video lottery repeal
14 and recovery fund established under § 42-7A-66. Any disbursement from the lottery
15 operating fund shall be by authorization of the executive director for any of the following
16 purposes:

- 17 (1) The payment of prizes to the holders of valid, winning lottery tickets;
18 (2) Expenses of the lottery, which shall include all costs incurred in the operation and
19 administration of the South Dakota Lottery; all costs resulting from contracts
20 entered into for the purchase or lease of goods and services needed for operation
21 of the lottery, including supplies, materials, tickets, independent studies and
22 surveys, data transmission, ~~advertising,~~ printing, ~~promotion,~~ incentives, public
23 relations, communications, compensation paid to lottery retailers; distribution of
24 tickets; and reimbursement of costs of facilities and services provided by other state
25 agencies; ~~and~~
26 (3) Transfers of net proceeds to the state general fund; and
27 (4) Transfers to the video lottery repeal and recovery fund.
