1An Act to provide an affirmative defense to pregnant women for certain controlled2substance offenses.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

5 22-42-23. Controlled Substance--Pregnant--Assault. If a woman is charged with a crime under violating § 22-42-5 or 22-42-5.1 while 6 pregnant and she was pregnant when the violation occurred, it is an affirmative defense 7 8 to the charge if the woman provides proof that she: 9 (1) received Received adequate prenatal care, actively from a licensed healthcare 10 professional during her pregnancy; 11 (2) Actively enrolled in an addiction recovery program before the child is born, 12 remained was born; 13 (3) Remained in the program after delivery, and successfully; and 14 (4) Successfully completed the program, regardless of whether the child was born with was harmed by a controlled substance. 15 a physical dependence
