MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- SCR 603 (Deferred from 29th LD) Recognizing the importance of gun safety.
(Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
- HCR 6013 Urging all South Dakotans to participate in the 2020 United States Census.
(Introduced)
- HCR 6008 To authorize a legislative study for the continuum of care for the disabled and elderly of South Dakota. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1124 provide for an increase in the assessment against certain treated land.
(Introduced)
- HB 1279 require property owners to receive notification of property tax reduction programs. (Introduced)
- HB 1244 authorize forensic medical examinations for certain persons.
(House Judiciary Engrossed)
- HCR 6004 To create a task force for the purpose of reviewing the manner in which mental health services are delivered in this state and considering changes to existing models or alternative models that could be utilized for the delivery of mental health services on a regional basis in this state. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 41 authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the construction of a facilities building at the University of South Dakota and to make an appropriation therefor. (Introduced)
- SB 42 authorize the Board of Regents to demolish three storage structures and contract for the construction of a grounds facility at the University of South Dakota and to make an appropriation therefor. (Introduced)

SB 43 authorize the South Dakota Building Authority to issue revenue bonds to provide for maintenance and repair on facilities controlled by the Board of Regents and to provide appropriation therefor. (Introduced)
