MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HCR 6020 (Deferred from 29th LD) Denouncing the National Education Association's recent policy to support "the fundamental right to abortion." (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 174 revise the purposes for which a school district's capital outlay fund may be used. (Introduced)
- SB 5 provide immunity for qualified mental health professionals at appropriate regional facilities. (Introduced)
- SB 65 revise certain provisions pertaining to trusts. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 176 provide for the seizure and holding of real property as evidence. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 162 provide limitations on the use of lighting equipment while hunting. (Senate Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 16 make an appropriation to reimburse certain health care professionals who have complied with the requirements for certain health care recruitment assistance programs and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 37 make an appropriation for costs related to disasters in the state and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 170 revise certain provisions regarding school district capital outlay funds. (Senate Engrossed)
- SB 74 revise provisions regarding legislative candidates. (Introduced)
- SB 128 revise entities who may contribute to a political committee. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)

- SB 80 revise certain sheriff's fees and costs. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 146 revise provisions related to tribal identification cards.
(Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
