A LEGISLATIVE COMMEMORATION, Honoring Kendal Waltner for winning the South 1 2 Dakota State Historical Society essay contest. 3 WHEREAS, for the 2019 Archaeology and Historic Preservation month, the South Dakota 4 State Historical Society sponsored a statewide essay contest for all fourth-grade students. 5 Tea fourth graders won the South Dakota State Historical Society essay contest; and 6 WHEREAS, students were asked to draft an essay using the theme of "This Place Matters." 7 Fifty-eight entries were received during the contest. The first-place winner was Kendal 8 Waltner from Tea Area Legacy Elementary School; and 9 WHEREAS, Kendal won two hundred dollars in the essay contest. She was among 10 participants from fifteen towns, fourteen schools, and three homeschooled students. Her outstanding writing skills about a topic she cared about won her the award: 11 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT COMMEMORATED, by the Ninety-Fifth Legislature of the State

of South Dakota, that the Legislature show its congratulations toward Kendal for her incredible accomplishment in this essay contest. Kendal has a bright and influential future ahead of her.
