MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- SB 75 (Consideration of House Amendments) provide for a habitat stamp on hunting and fishing licenses. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed)
- HCR 6003 Supporting the Electoral College. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HCR 6005 Commending the nation of Israel for its cordial and mutually beneficial relationship with the United States and with the State of South Dakota. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HCR 6012 Supporting the right to pray in public schools. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HCR 6004 (Removed from Consent) To create a task force for the purpose of reviewing the manner in which mental health services are delivered in this state and considering changes to existing models or alternative models that could be utilized for the delivery of mental health services on a regional basis in this state. (Introduced)
- HCR 6014 To encourage the Department of Game, Fish and Parks in 2020, as part of the biennial review of endangered and threatened species, to delist the river otter and manage this species as a harvested furbearer if scientifically-sound biological and ecological data support such a decision. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- HB 1107 define style and form and authorize the code commission to make certain style and form edits to legislative acts. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1195 provide an affirmative defense to pregnant women for certain controlled substance offenses. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- HB 1255 remove the requirement for a mandatory appraisal in exchanges of land between school districts. (Introduced)
- HB 1068 include out-of-state convictions for the basis of an enhanced penalty for the crime of stalking. (Introduced) (PJPCE)

- HCR 6011 Supporting the Recovering America's Wildlife Act. (Introduced)
- HCR 6015 To provide for a legislative task force to study, report, and develop and consider recommendations and proposed legislation regarding the evaluation and standardization of quality measurements of agricultural products.
(Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 40 authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the construction of an Allied Health Facility and the demolition of Julian Hall and the Julian Hall Addition to the University of South Dakota, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 17 make an appropriation for the plugging and surface reclamation of natural gas wells and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- SB 118 revise certain educational programs and promote efficiency in state government and to make an appropriation therefor. (Introduced)

- HB 1166 revise provisions regarding the appointment of inactive watershed district boards and the reactivation of watershed districts and to declare an emergency. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- HB 1054 revise the documentation required for voter registration.

- HB 1094 repeal certain provisions regarding permits for concealed pistols. (Introduced)
- HB 1169 prohibit the use of certain electronic devices while driving.
(House Transportation Engrossed)
- HB 1179 authorize series limited liability companies. (Introduced)
- HB 1184 provide limited deer and antelope licenses to landowners. (House Engrossed)
- HB 1065 (Deferred from 30th LD) revise drone surveillance protections.
(Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
