4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
5	Section 1. That a NEW SECTION be added:
6	22-42-23. Controlled SubstancePregnantAssault.
7	If a woman is charged with violating § 22-42-5 or 22-42-5.1 and she was pregnant
8	when the violation occurred, it is an affirmative defense to the state shall dismiss the
9	charge if the woman provides proof that she:
10	(1) Received adequate prenatal care from a licensed health care professional during
11	her pregnancy;
12	(2) Actively enrolled in an addiction recovery program before the child was born;
13	(3) Remained in the program after delivery; and
14	(4) Successfully completed the program.
