1 **An Act to revise certain provisions regarding documents of the Legislature.**

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 ~~2-16-13.~~

4 **Section 1.** That § 2-7-5 be AMENDED:

5 **2-7-5. Prefiled bills--Numbering, printing, and disposition--Introduction.**

6 The director of the Legislative Research Council shall, ~~within the confines of such~~
 7 in accordance with rules adopted by the Legislature, receive ~~such~~ the prefiled bills and
 8 resolutions, place them in proper form, and assign them numbers for introduction in the
 9 proper house, ~~and deliver copies to the printing contractor for pre-session printing.~~ The
 10 director shall electronically deliver ~~the original and one copy~~ of each bill and resolution to
 11 the secretary of the Senate or the chief clerk of the House of Representatives, as the case
 12 may be, on the day when the session convenes. However, the director may not deliver
 13 any prefiled bill or resolution until every sponsor of ~~such~~ the bill or resolution has been
 14 duly sworn into office.

15 Upon prefiling, ~~such~~ the bills and resolutions become the property of the Legislature
 16 and may not thereafter be withdrawn. Prefiled bills and resolutions shall be considered as
 17 introduced on the ~~day of their delivery to each house~~ first legislative day.

18 **Section 2.** That § 2-7-6 be REPEALED.

19 **2-7-6. Contract covering printing of prefiled bills and resolutions.**

20 **Section 3.** That § 2-7-8 be REPEALED.

1 **2-7-8. Time of delivery of daily legislative journals--Penalty for delay--**
2 **Waiver.**

3 **Section 4.** That § 2-7-11 be AMENDED:

4 **2-7-11. Index and distribution of journals.**

5 The ~~contractor for printing~~ Legislative Research Council shall prepare and include
6 the journal indexes of the Legislature ~~shall deliver them to the Legislative Research Council~~
7 within ninety days after copy therefor has been furnished. The Legislative Research
8 Council shall provide for the electronic distribution of the daily journals. ~~Price and~~
9 ~~distribution of the journal indexes shall be determined by a joint select committee of the~~
10 ~~Legislature~~ at least two hours before the convening of the Legislature on the next
11 legislative day.

12 **Section 5.** That § 2-7-14 be REPEALED.

13 **2-7-14. Time allowed for printing of bills and resolutions.**

14 **Section 6.** That § 2-7-15.1 be REPEALED.

15 **2-7-15.1. Fees for copies of bills and journals--Mailing fees--Disposition.**

16 **Section 7.** That § 2-9-33 be AMENDED:

17 **2-9-33. Prison or jail population--Cost estimate--Requirements.**

18 A prison or jail population cost estimate shall be electronically attached to any bill
19 or amendment, except misdemeanor penalties, that may impact the state prison or county
20 jail population. A prison or jail population cost estimate shall be prepared for a bill or
21 amendment with a Class 1 misdemeanor penalty only upon a request authorized by the
22 rules of the Legislature. The requirement for a cost estimate includes each bill or
23 amendment that meets the penalty requirements of this section and that increases the
24 period of imprisonment authorized for an existing crime, that adds a new crime for which
25 imprisonment is authorized, that imposes a minimum or mandatory minimum term of
26 imprisonment, or that modifies any law governing release of a prisoner from imprisonment
27 or supervision.

28 The sponsor of the legislation or amendment shall ~~request and~~ allow sufficient time to
29 prepare a cost estimate from the Legislative Research Council. The cost estimate shall be

1 completed for a bill or amendment before final disposition is taken on the bill or
2 amendment ~~is considered~~ by any standing committee of the Legislature.

3 **Section 8.** That § 2-7-4 be AMENDED:

4 **2-7-4. Prefiled bills--Persons authorized--Rules.**

5 Any person who has been duly elected or appointed to serve during a regular
6 session of the Legislature may file bills and resolutions with the ~~State~~ Legislative Research
7 Council at any time within thirty days prior to the convening of such regular session.
8 Notwithstanding the provisions of § 2-7-6.1, any interim committee of the Legislative
9 Research Council may file bills and resolutions under the provisions of this section. The
10 Executive Board of the ~~State~~ Legislative Research Council shall prescribe rules for the
11 handling and placing in proper form of such bills and resolutions, subject to the provisions
12 of §§ 2-7-4 to ~~2-7-6~~, inclusive and 2-7-5.

13 **Section 9.** That § 2-16-10.2 be AMENDED:

14 **2-16-10.2. South Dakota Codified Laws provided to Legislature--Codified**
15 **Laws and Administrative Rules provided to legislators.**

16 The Code Commission shall provide the Legislature with sets of the South Dakota
17 Codified Laws. The Code Commission may provide each legislator with a copy of the South
18 Dakota Codified Laws, the Administrative Rules of South Dakota and other information ~~on~~
19 ~~a CD-ROM disc or other in a~~ digital format. ~~An individual legislator may request one copy~~
20 ~~of the code identified in § 2-16-13.~~
