MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

- SB 146 (Consideration of House Amendments) revise provisions related to tribal identification cards. (House Engrossed)
- SR 702 Calling for statewide recognition of South Dakota's military veteran entrepreneurs and Bunker Labs of Rapid City. (Introduced)
- HCR 6016 Supporting the efforts of William "Bill" Casper as the South Dakota state chairman of the State Funeral for World War II Veterans in his efforts to petition President Donald J. Trump to hold a state funeral for World War II veterans. (Introduced)
- HCR 6017 to encourage the creation of an interim legislative study to address infrastructure and funding support related to the expansion of Ellsworth Air Force Base. (House Engrossed)
- HCR 6015 (Removed from Consent) To provide for a legislative task force to study, report, and develop and consider recommendations and proposed legislation regarding the evaluation and standardization of quality measurements of agricultural products. (Introduced)

- HB 1154 revise certain provisions regarding motor vehicle license plates. (House Transportation Engrossed)
- HB 1264 revise provisions regarding the procurement of public improvements. (House Local Government Engrossed)
- HB 1069 authorize certain veterans to attend courses offered at postsecondary technical institutes without payment of tuition. (Introduced)
- HB 1077 establish certain requirements regarding funeral processions. (House Judiciary Engrossed)
- HB 1259 clarify provisions regarding the discretionary formula for determining the assessed value of property for tax purposes. (House Taxation Engrossed)

- HB 1089 provide for the discharge of certain persons who received a suspended imposition of sentence for a misdemeanor. (Introduced)
- HB 1103 authorize the forensic medical examination of certain minor victims without parental or guardian consent. (Introduced)
- HB 1108 adopt the Uniform Civil Remedies for Unauthorized Disclosure of Intimate Images Act. (Introduced)
- HB 1123 revise provisions regarding termination of a lease by a victim of alleged domestic abuse. (House Engrossed)
- HB 1138 establish shooting course requirements for current or former law enforcement officers seeking an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol. (House State Affairs Engrossed)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1008 (Deferred from 27th LD) legalize the growth, production, and transportation of industrial hemp in the state, and to declare an emergency. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- HB 1067 modify certain provisions regarding notice, service, and execution of judgments. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- HB 1117 repeal and revise certain provisions regarding riot, to establish the crime of incitement to riot, and to revise provisions regarding civil liability for riot and riot boosting. (Introduced) (PJPCE)
- HB 1107 (Removed from Consent) define style and form and authorize the code commission to make certain style and form edits to legislative acts. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1195 (Removed from Consent) provide an affirmative defense to pregnant women for certain controlled substance offenses. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- HB 1068 (Removed from Consent) include out-of-state convictions for the basis of an enhanced penalty for the crime of stalking. (Introduced) (PJPCE)
- HB 1207 extend the termination date for the Juvenile Justice Public Safety Oversight Council. (Introduced)
