A LEGISLATIVE COMMEMORATION, Honoring Kendal Waltner for winning the South Dakota State Historical Society essay contest.

WHEREAS, for the 2019 Archaeology and Historic Preservation month, the South Dakota State Historical Society sponsored a statewide essay contest for all fourth grade students. Tea fourth graders won the South Dakota State Historical Society essay contest; and

WHEREAS, students were asked to draft an essay using the theme of "This Place Matters." Fifty-eight entries were received during the contest. The first-place winner was Kendal Waltner from Tea Area Legacy Elementary School; and
