## House Bill 1213

## AMENDMENT 1213B FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

- 1 An Act to preclude the assignment of exclusive broadcast rights for certain high
- 2 school interscholastic activities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-36-4 be AMENDED:
- 5 13-36-4. Delegation of control, supervision, and regulation of high school interscholastic
- 6 activities to association.
- 7 The school board of a public school, approved and accredited by the secretary of the
- 8 Department of Education, may delegate, on a year to year basis, the control, supervision, and
- 9 regulation of any high school interscholastic activities to any association which is voluntary
- 10 and nonprofit if:
- 11 (1) Membership in the association is open to all high schools approved and accredited
- 12 pursuant to this section, including any school that allows participation by students receiving
- 13 alternative instruction as set forth in § 13-27-3, pursuant to the provisions of this title;
- 14 (2) The constitution, bylaws, and rules of the association are subject to ratification by the
- 15 school boards of the member public school districts and the governing boards of the member
- 16 nonpublic schools and include a provision for a proper review procedure and review board;
- 17 (3) The report of any audit required by § 13-26-5 is made public on the association's
- 18 website as well as the Department of Legislative Audit's website;
- 19 (4) The association complies with the provisions of chapter 1-25 and chapter 1-27.
- 20 However, the association, and its employees, meetings, and records, are afforded the same
- 21 exemptions and protections as a political subdivision or public body is provided under chapter
- 22 <del>1-25 and chapter 1-27; and</del>
- 23 (5) The association shall report to the Government Operations and Audit Committee
- 24 annually, or at the call of the chair.
- 25 The governing body of a nonpublic school, approved and accredited by the secretary of the
- 26 Department of Education, or AdvancED, or the Association of Christian Schools International
- 27 (ACSI), or the Association of Classical and Christian Schools (ACCS), or Christian Schools
- 28 International (CSI), or National Lutheran School Accreditation (NLSA), or Commission for

Oceti Sakowin Accreditation (COSA), or Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod School 1 2 Accreditation, may also delegate, on a year to year basis, the control, supervision, and regulation of any high school interscholastic activities to any association which is voluntary 3 4 and nonprofit if membership in such association is open to all high schools approved and 5 accredited pursuant to this section, including any school that allows participation by students 6 receiving alternative instruction as set forth in § 13-27-3, pursuant to the provisions of this 7 title, and if the constitution, bylaws, and rules of the association are subject to ratification by 8 the school boards of the member public school districts and the governing boards of the 9 member nonpublic schools and include a provision for a proper review procedure and review 10 board.

- 11 Any association which that complies with this section may exercise the control, supervision,
- 12 and regulation of interscholastic activities, including interscholastic athletic events of member
- 13 schools, except as otherwise provided in § 13-36-4.1. The association may promulgate
- 14 reasonable uniform rules, to make decisions and to provide and enforce reasonable penalties
- 15 for the violation of the rules.

## 16 Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added:

- 17 Exclusive broadcast rights—Assignment—Limitation.
- 18 The authority to exercise control, supervision, and regulation of interscholastic activities,
- 19 <u>including interscholastic athletic events, as set forth in § 13-36-4, does not include the</u>
- 20 <u>authority to grant or assign exclusive broadcast rights for state-level events to a media</u>
- 21 contractor.
