### REVISED

#### SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1266 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) prohibit collective bargaining by employees of the Board of Regents. (Introduced)
- HB 1046 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the design, renovation of, and addition to, the Devereaux Library on the campus of the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology and to make an appropriation therefor. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1233 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) make an appropriation to the gaming commission fund, to provide for the transfer of funds to the special racing revolving fund and the South Dakota-bred racing fund, and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1100 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) make an appropriation to begin the research and development of a new bioprocessing facility and to declare an emergency. (Joint Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1277 prevent trafficking, coercion, and exploitation that occurs under the guise of obscene content. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- HB 1008 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) legalize the growth, production, and transportation of industrial hemp in the state, and to declare an emergency. (House Agriculture and Natural Resources Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- HB 1189 make an appropriation to expand rural access to broadband services and to declare an emergency. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1187 make an appropriation to upgrade the state radio infrastructure system and to declare an emergency. (House Appropriations Engrossed)
- HB 1213 (Deferred from 33<sup>rd</sup> LD) enhance education in South Dakota. (Senate Education Engrossed)
