Senate Bill 194

An Act to revise certain requirements for absentee ballots and to declare an emergency.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** If an absentee ballot application does not contain an oath or a copy of the voter's
- 5 <u>identification card as required by § 12-19-2 due to a public health crisis, the applicant may</u>
- 6 <u>complete a personal identification affidavit on a form prescribed by the secretary of state. The</u>
- 7 affidavit shall require the voter to provide the following information to establish identity:
- 8 (1) Name as listed on the official registration list;
- 9 (2) Current address of residence;
- 10 (3) Date of birth;

- 11 (4) One of the following identifying numbers:
- 12 <u>(a) South Dakota driver license number;</u>
- (b) South Dakota nondriver identification card number; or
- 14 (c) Last four digits of Social Security number.
- 15 <u>The voter shall sign the affidavit under penalty set forth in § 12-26-7 for</u> 16 impersonation of a registered voter.
 - If the absentee ballot application is accompanied by the voter's personal identification affidavit, the affidavit shall be maintained by the person in charge of the election pursuant to § 12-20-31. However, the voter's personal identification affidavit is not available for public inspection.
- 21 **Section 2.** This Act is repealed on August 1, 2020.
- 22 **Section 3.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,
- health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force
- and effect from and after its passage and approval.
