- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain taxes on express companies.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 10-32-1 be repealed.
- 4 10-32-1. Every person, company, joint stock association or corporation, wherever organized
- 5 or incorporated, engaged in the business of conveying to, from, or through this state, or any part
- 6 thereof, money, packages, gold, silver plate, or other articles, by express, shall be deemed to be
- 7 an express company.
- 8 Section 2. That §§ 10-32-2 to 10-32-11, inclusive, be repealed.
