1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain taxes on telegraph companies.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 10-34-1 be repealed.

4 ~~— 10-34-1. Any person owning or operating any telegraph line in this state, with appliances for~~  
5 ~~the transmission of messages and engaged in the business of furnishing telegraph service for~~  
6 ~~compensation, as owner, lessee, or otherwise, shall be deemed, held, and known as a telegraph~~  
7 ~~company.~~

8 Section 2. That §§ 10-34-2 to 10-34-16, inclusive, be repealed.
