- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow the state auditor to temporarily draw on money
- 2 between state funds in anticipation of revenue.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 4-8-14 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 4-8-14. Whenever If moneys shall for the state have been actually provided for any funds of
- 6 the state by levy of taxes, sale of bonds or warrants, or otherwise, and such the moneys shall not
- 7 have not been actually collected and covered into the state treasury, but concerning the receipt
- 8 of which the moneys there can be no question is certain, the state board of finance is authorized,
- 9 by a majority vote to auditor may anticipate the receipt of such the moneys into such the fund
- by drawing temporarily upon the moneys in any other fund of the state for which there shall not
- 11 be is not an immediate use.
- 12 Section 2. That § 4-8-14.1 be amended to read as follows:
- 4-8-14.1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the state board of finance may
- 14 authorize the state auditor to may issue warrants on such any money as is actually provided for

- pursuant to § 4-8-14 in an amount not to exceed the amount of revenues anticipated.
- 2 Section 3. That § 4-8-15 be amended to read as follows:
- 3 4-8-15. Any fund temporarily depleted by virtue of § 4-8-14 shall be fully restored within six
- 4 months after a draft of same for another fund shall have been made. The board of finance shall
- 5 provide for reimbursing the fund from which funds are temporarily withdrawn.
- 6 The books of the state treasurer shall at all times show the true amount of moneys in any
- 7 particular fund, as well as any temporary withdrawal therefrom the time frame specified and
- 8 approved by the state auditor, but not to exceed one year.
- 9 Section 4. That chapter 4-8 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 The state auditor shall promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26 for authorizing, monitoring,
- and controlling the temporary draw of money between state funds.
