- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 21-18-51 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 21-18-51. The maximum part of the aggregate disposable earnings of an individual for any
- 6 workweek which is subject to garnishment may not exceed the lesser of:
- 7 (1) Twenty percent of disposable earnings for that week;
- The amount by which disposable earnings for that week exceed forty times the federal minimum hourly wage prescribed by section 6(a)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, as amended and in effect on January 1, 1989 1997, Pub. L. 95-151; 91 Stat. 1245; 29 U.S.C. 206, or any equivalent multiple thereof prescribed by regulation by the secretary of labor in case of earnings for any pay period other than a week, in effect at the time the earnings are payable less twenty-five dollars per week for each
