- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt certain communications and computer
- 2 technologies and equipment from bidding requirements.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 5-18-18 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 5-18-18. The provisions of §§ 5-18-1 to 5-18-17, inclusive, may not be construed to do not
- 6 regulate or apply to contracts entered into and purchases made by the Department of
- 7 Transportation or by the Bureau of Administration or to the purchase of electric power, light,
- 8 water or gas; or any municipal corporation for the purchase of materials, supplies, or equipment
- 9 for any utility owned or operated by such municipal corporation, provided that such purchase
- 10 may if the purchase does not exceed the sum of eleven thousand dollars; or to contracts of any
- municipal corporation in time of war to acquire, establish, construct, own, control, lease, equip,
- improve, maintain, operate, or regulate an airport or landing field for the use of airplanes or other
- aircraft, of the United States armed forces or its members, students, and mechanics; or to
- 14 contracts of any public corporation for the purchase of materials, supplies or equipment from the
- 15 United States or its agencies; or to equipment repair contracts; or to the contracts of any school
- district for the purchase of communications technologies, computers, peripheral equipment, and

- 1 <u>related connectivity;</u> or to the purchase of surplus property from another public corporation; or
- 2 to the purchase by one local government entity from the lowest responsible bidder of an item
- 3 competitively bid in the previous twelve months by itself or another local government entity or
- 4 the state at the bid price or less; or to animals purchased by a municipality for a zoo.
