- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to assess the costs of rescue against vehicle operators who
- 2 fail to heed a notice of the temporary restriction or closing of a state trunk highway.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 31-4-14.3 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 31-4-14.3. Any person who intentionally fails to observe any sign, marker, warning, notice
- or direction, or barrier placed or given under § 31-4-14.2 is guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor. If,
- 7 <u>as a result of a violation of this section for failure to observe a notice provided pursuant to</u>
- 8 subdivision (1), (4), or (5) of § 31-4-14.2, any agency of the State of South Dakota or any
- 9 governmental subdivision incurs any costs for the purpose of rescuing the violator, any
- passengers, or the vehicle operated by the violator, the violator is civilly liable to the State of
- 11 South Dakota for such costs, not to exceed ten thousand dollars.
