1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to clarify the time when wages are due by the employer of
2 a separated employee.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 60-11-10 be amended to read as follows:

5 60-11-10. Whenever an employer separates an employee from the payroll, the unpaid wages
6 or compensation of such employee ~~shall become~~ are due and payable not later than the next
7 regular stated pay day for which those hours would have normally been paid or as soon
8 thereafter as the employee returns to the employer all property of the employer in the employee's
9 possession.
