- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to clarify certain provisions relating to insurance arbitration
- 2 between insurance companies.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 21-25A-3 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 21-25A-3. This chapter shall does not apply to insurance policies and every provision in any
- 6 such policy requiring arbitration or restricting a party thereto or beneficiary thereof from
- 7 enforcing his rights any right under it by usual legal proceedings in ordinary tribunals or limiting
- 8 his the time to do so is void and unenforceable. However, nothing in this chapter may be deemed
- 9 to impair the enforcement of or invalidate a contractual provision for arbitration entered into
- 10 between insurance companies.
