- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to expand the definition of the crime of stalking.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 22-19A-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 22-19A-1. Any person who:
- 5 (1) Who, without any legal purpose, willfully, maliciously, and repeatedly follows or
- 6 harasses another person with the intent to seriously alarm or annoy that person; or
- 7 who
- 8 (2) Who makes a credible threat to another person with the intent to place that person in
- 9 reasonable fear of death or great bodily injury;
- is guilty of the crime of stalking. Stalking is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
