- 3 Section 1. That § 22-19A-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 22-19A-1. Any person-who:
- 5 (1) Who willfully, maliciously, and repeatedly follows or harasses another person; or who
- 6 <u>(2)</u> <u>Who</u> makes a credible threat to another person with the intent to place that person in
- 7 reasonable fear of death or great bodily injury;
- 8 is guilty of the crime of stalking. Stalking is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
